## Sample Plan of Study, Transfers, Changing Colleges, Post-Bacs - Spring 2023 and Later Sessions

### Requirements

- Admission to the <u>Teacher Education Program</u> (TEP)
- Completion of the course requirements listed below or approved substitutes in accordance with the <u>Teacher</u> <u>education Program Policies</u>.
- Completion of General Education CLAS Core requirements using the Supplemental General Education Guide
- All coursework must be completed prior to student teaching.
- Candidates must also earn at least a C- in all TEP Courses
- Sample course plans represent one way to complete a program of study. Actual course selection and sequence will vary and should be discussed with an academic advisor.

Prior to being admitted to the TEP students may take CLAS Core General Education requirements, Foundation Courses [EPLS:3000, PSQF:1075, EDTL:4900, or EDTL:2122], or courses for endorsements, as needed. Foundation courses can be completed prior to admission to Elementary Education program but are not prerequisites for admission.
